
The Mystery at the Birdfeeder Some sample pages.

Purdy, an English Setter, looks after the yard.




I looked out of the window and the birdfeeder was lying on the ground. It was not broken, but the seed was all gone. What happened?


The last of the winter snow had fallen on the ground. I didn't see any birds, any animals, or any tracks. I needed to find out what happened!




We filled the birdfeeder again and hung it in its place. I sat on my dog house to see what I could find out.













"I'll be back to snack later!!!!!" sang Nancy as she flew away. "Well, she didn't eat much," Carl chirped to me.
